Christian Classics: The Beatitudes by Charles H. Spurgeon

Charles H. Spurgeon (1834–1892), known as the "Prince of Preachers," was a British Baptist preacher who is still highly influential among Christians of various denominations. A powerful orator and prolific author, he frequently preached to audiences of more than 10,000 people—all in the days before electronic amplification!

The Present Word: Sovereignty of God
